- 6. Mazda 3S: 30.3 percent
- 7. Volkswagen GTI: 30.3 percent
- 8. Dodge Stratus SXT: 30.2 percent
- 9. Acura 3.0S/CL: 30.1 percent
- 10. Toyota Tacoma: 30.1 percent

- 2. Lexus IS350: 3.4 percent
- 3. Acura ILX: 5.6 percent

- 7. GMC Savana: 8.8 percent
- 8. Audi A3 2 Series: 9.2 percent
- 9. BMW 320I: 9.9 percent
- 10. Land Rover Range Rover: 10.9 percent
